JUNIOR GOLF LEADER ANNUAL AWARD

To promote our junior golf program, a point-based system has been set up to encourage competition among our juniors. The top point winners at the end of the scheduled dates will be rewarded with special prizes. A running total of each participant's points will be kept by the Golf Shop Staff and will be displayed in a prominent location on the Junior Golf Board. So Juniors — get involved! Remember to always check-in with the staff so that an accurate record of your points is always available!

Cliff Wagner has been with Oakbourne since 1992. Cliff is from Long Beach, Mississippi and played collegiate golf for the University of Southern Mississippi. Cliff won the 1993 LA Apprentice Chapter Championship and was named Player of the Year in 1994. In 1997 Cliff finished runner-up in the LA Chapter Championship.

Cliff has attended many PGA instructional schools and has participated in the International Coaching and Teaching Summit eight times. He was named 2001 Gulf States PGA Professional of the Year and 2002 Gulf States Section Junior Golf Leader. Cliff was the 2007 Barbato/Thomas Award recipient for promoting golf in the state of Louisiana and the 2008 Louisiana Chapter Golf Professional of the Year. Cliff is a certified PGA instructor, a distinction only 4% of PGA professionals receive. He is a Certified US Kids Instructor, Positive Coaching Alliance member and a Titleist Performance Institute Certified Instructor. Cliff's most recent accomplishments are being awarded the 2014 Gulf States PGA Horton Smith Award for promoting education in the PGA. He was also awarded the Louisiana Chapter Professional of Year award in 2015 and 2017.

Justin Mann is originally from Natchitoches, LA and came to Oakbourne from Links on the Bayou Golf Course in Alexandria, LA. 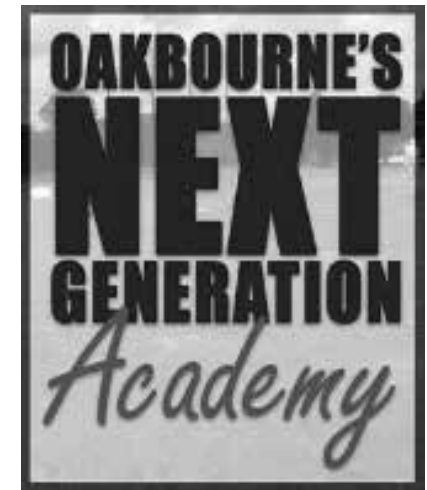
